4. How does the playscript describe the way the scene is set?
5. How do you know who is speaking?
6. How are actions of the actors described?
7. How do you know when the actors are DOING something, and not SAYING something?
8. Does the playscript give a lot of detail to explain the movement of the actors?
9. Find SIX words that show that this playscript is written in the present tense.
- 10 State TWO actions that are given in the playscript. (Things that the actors DO, but not say.
