$$2 + \underline{3} = 5$$

bonds to 5

$$\underline{\quad} + 1 = 6$$

$$2 + \underline{\quad} = 6$$

$$4 + \underline{\quad} = 6$$

$$6 - \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$$

$$3 + \underline{\quad} = 6$$

$$3 + \underline{\quad} = 6$$

$$6 - \underline{\quad} = 3$$
