To save him, Moses was put in a basket and floated down the Nile by his mother



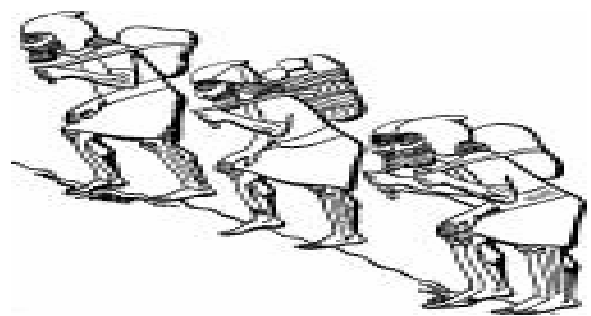
He was saved by people by the river. He was taken to the Pharaoh's house.
